4. FIRST AID MEASURES

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Potential Health Effects/Symptoms

Inhalation: Inhalation of vapors or mists of the product may be irritating to the respiratory system. When

heated to temperatures exceeding 300° F (150° C) in the presence of air, silicones may form formaldehyde vapors. Formaldehyde is a potential cancer hazard and a known skin and respiratory sensitizer. Vapors irritate the eyes, nose and throat. Safe handling conditions may be maintained by keeping formaldehyde vapor concentrations below the OSHA permissible limit. The silane is a skin and eye irritant and prolonged contact may cause eye and skin burns. The low concentration makes such overexposure unlikely and minimizes its affect on health

and safety.

Skin contact: Causes skin irritation. May cause allergic skin reaction.

Eye contact: Causes serious eye irritation.
